- Application Period has closed for FMA and BRIC
- Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) FY 2020
  - Subapplications received: 22
  - Submitted to FEMA: 17 projects for a total of \$6,127,496
- Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) FY 2020
  - Subapplications received: 68
  - o Submitted to FEMA: 20 projects for a total of \$195,370,361
- Subapplicants will be notified of FEMA's determinations when we receive them

# Agenda Item: Floodplain Management

## Discussion:

- New SCORE CAV (State Coordinating Office Regional Engagement Community Assistance Visits) process has been successful since it was implemented in December 2018
  - Open CAVs: 49 communities
  - Closed CAVs: 155 communities
  - Total SCORE CAVs: 204 communities
  - o FEMA is considering promoting this as a nationwide model
- Florida Flood Awareness Week from the Florida Floodplain Management Association is the second week in March

# Agenda Item: Insurance Sector Update

#### Discussion:

- Federal
  - HR 3167 introduced in 2019 to address long term reauthorizing of NFIP; affordability;
    mapping; mitigation; and availability of loss data
- Florida
  - SB 728 and HB 733 Credit for Reinsurance (check out the most recent Bulletin Newsletter for Barbara's article on Reinsurance)
    - https://flsenate.gov/Session/Bill/2021/728/Analyses/2021s00728.bi.PDF
  - HB 1623 Climate and Resiliency Task Force identify protection gaps in state's insurance market; assess and recommend risk-transfer mechanisms; reducing and mitigating climate-related risk; and more
  - o HB 717 Consumer Protection

## Discussion:

- Phase I deliverables are being finalized
- Outcomes:
  - Task 1: Inventory data and identify data gaps
  - Task 2: WMP development strategy and prioritization tool
  - Task 3: Instructional manual for screening tool
  - Task 4: Statewide catalog including best practice examples
  - o Task 5: WMP template, two WMPs both coastal and inland
- Phase II Concept is forthcoming

# Agenda Item: LiDAR Update

#### Discussion:

- Florida Peninsular LiDAR Update
  - Project is 68% complete
  - COVID-19 delayed the post-processing of contractor deliverables
    - Final deliverable release date revised to December 2021
  - 3 counties have been fully accepted by USGS
    - Nassau, Sumter, Collier
  - Once all counties have been accepted by USGS, final deliverables, by County, will be posted to the USGS National Map for download
- Hurricane Michael LiDAR Supplemental Project

- o Project is 69% complete
- Acquisition was completed between 12/15/2019 and 4/22/2020
- First Block deliverable (Jefferson and Wakulla) have been delivered to USGS for final QA/QC
- Remaining Blocks currently in production
- Final deliverables are still on schedule to be completed, accepted, and posted to the USGS National Map for download by 12/31/2021

## Agenda Item: Florida Silver Jackets

#### Discussion:

- Ongoing Projects:
  - o Inland Resilience Pilot Project
    - Guidebooks and workbooks have been finalized for Columbia and Highlands counties
  - H&H Support for Lake Martin
    - The Silver Jackets team is supporting a project between the EPA, FEMA, and the cities of Parker and Springfield
    - H&H baseline model should be complete this summer
- FY 2021 Proposed Projects:
  - o Immokalee Regional Water Plan
    - Kick-off meeting held in January 2021
    - Bringing local, state, federal, and tribal partners together to develop a comprehensive solution to address flooding
  - Coastal Resilience Workshop
    - Virtual workshops targeted to local planners and engineers to make communities more resilient to coastal storms

## Discussion:

- DEP SLIP Rule
  - S. 161.551 F.S. requires DEP to develop and adopt rules for implementing the section
  - State financed constructors will have to assess potential impacts of sea level rise and storms on new coastal construction
  - Sea Level Rise Impact Projection (SLIP) Study Tool
    - Tool can be used by anyone to assess potential sea level rise impacts
- DEO Rebuild Florida Mitigation Programs
  - General Planning Support Awarded Entities:
    - 19 municipalities, 11 counties, 5 non-profits, and 2 universities

- Critical Facility Hardening Awarded Entities:
  - 43 municipalities and 18 counties
- General Infrastructure will be funded in 3 rounds
  - Round 1 is \$150 million
  - Awards will be announced soon
- Additional CDBG-MIT funding for Hurricane Michael impacted communities \$46.9
  million
