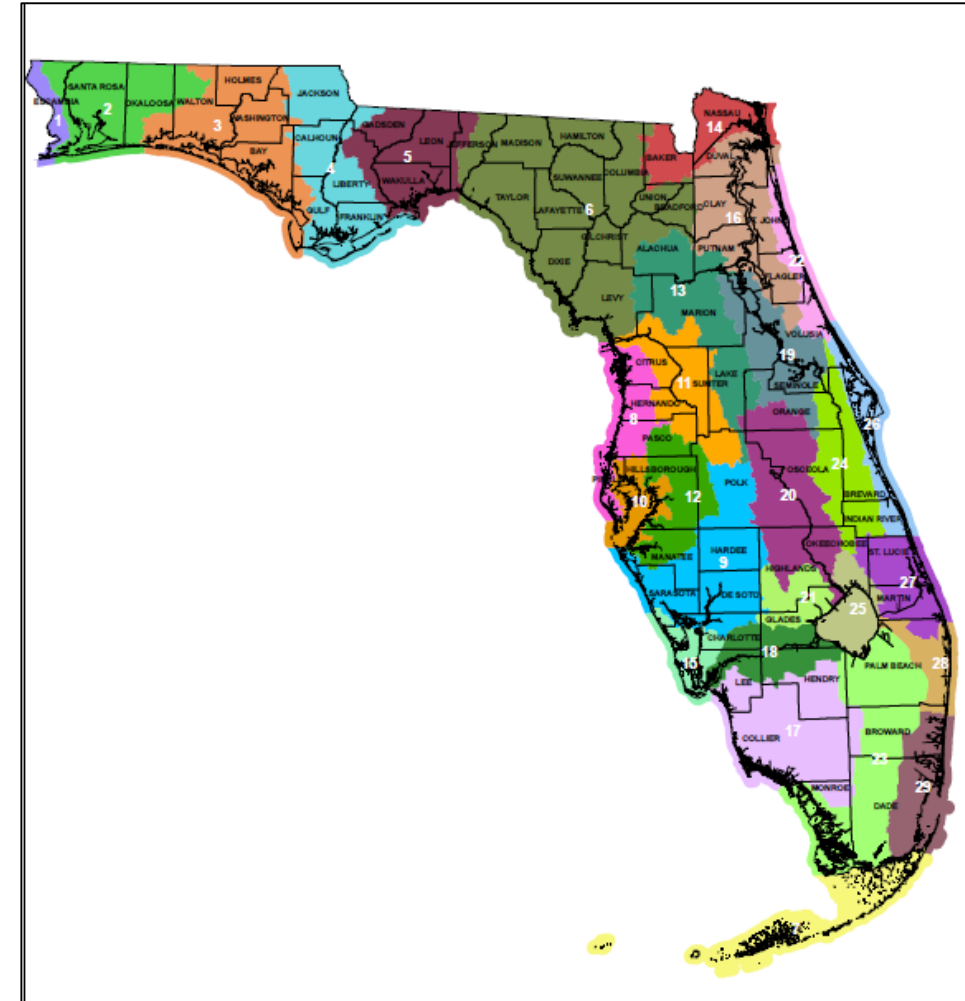
# Annual Report

# Watershed Master Planning Initiative

- HMGP \$20 million
- Create and Update Watershed Master Plans for all 29 Watersheds in Florida
- Goals:
  - Help communities guide future mitigation projects
  - Help communities move up in CRS
- Currently working to procure a contractor
- Working with Water Management Districts to collect data

# LiDAR Update

- Acquisition plan: <https://arcg.is/1zvjbq>
- New data will allow us to:
  - Generate a more detailed Digital Elevation and Surface Model
  - Generate Building Footprints
  - Update Storm Surge Models
  - Update Floodplain maps (eventually)
- Data will be publically available through USGS, NOAA, Water Management Districts, and possibly through a State Portal



# Wildfire Mitigation

- Coordinating with Florida Forest Service to update the GIS fuel layer →
  - Update risk mapping and analysis →
    - Update the wildfire mitigation plan
