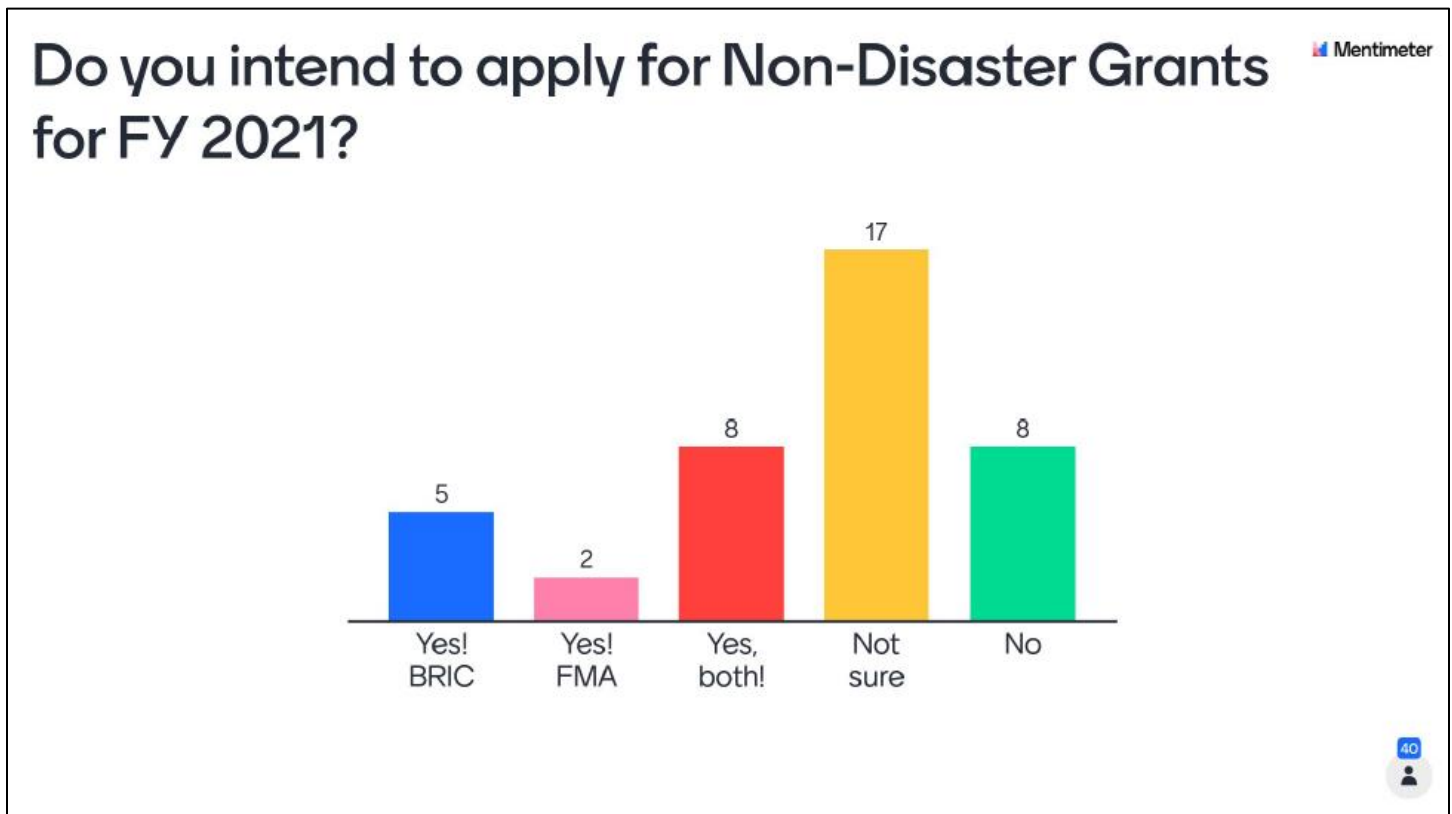

 - 161.551, F.S. passed; requires state-financed constructor to complete a SLIP study before completing construction of coastal structure

- New online tool to help complete the SLIP study and visualize projected SLR estimations;

- Resilient Florida
 - Program recently passed 380.093, F.S. with five major sections
 - Resilient Florida Grant Program: grant funding available for planning and infrastructure projects
 - Comprehensive Statewide Data Set and Vulnerability Assessments: must be completed by July 1, 2022
 - Statewide Flooding and Sea Level Rise Resilience Plan: including projects from vulnerability assessments, projects were submitted, and application period closed 9/1/2021
 - Regional Resilience Entities: funding for these entities to assist communities with technical assistance
 - Florida Flood Hub: College of Marine Science at USF will serve as the lead institution to support applied research and innovation to address the flooding and sea level rise challenges of the state
