

Debris Management Site Authorization Checklist

Disaster Debris Management Site (DDMS) is already pre-authorized by the Florida Department of Environmental protection

Disaster Debris Management Site (DDMS) is **NOT** pre-authorized by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection

Documentation Needed for New DDMS Authorization Request:

1. Site Map

Map Should Contain:

Site boundary and boundary of area within the site that will be used for debris management and processing

Structures

Sensitive Features (e.g., wetlands)

Debris Management Areas, labeled by debris type located in area

Processing Areas

Traffic Flow

2. DDMS Operation Plan

Plan Should Contain:

Type of debris processing that will be performed

Types of wastes managed

Process for managing unexpected/ unauthorized waste

Entities authorized to bring debris to the site

Storage location of site records

Days and hours of Site operation

3. Location of DDMS (street address and GPS coordinates)

4. Contact information of site manager

If site is not owned by government entity, copy of lease or approval needed

Debris Reduction Method:

Open Pile Burning

Pre-authorized by Florida Forestry Service

Disposal

Debris is disposed of in an appropriate manner (e.g., proper class landfill, composted, etc.)
