## What is the DRA?

The **Disaster Readiness Assessment (DRA)** is a required **questionnaire** that aims to identify how well your organization is **prepared to recover**.

All DRA questions are broken down into five sub-categories:

Applicant Experience Policy and Procedure

Documentation

Procuremen

Contract Administration

Here's how you can benefit from completing the DRA:

- Completing the DRA enables you to increase your overall F-ROC score, and therefore your ability to recover a higher percentage of funding upfront upon obligation.
- ✓ Completing the DRA enables you to identify risks in your organization.
- ✓ Completing the DRA offers abatement plans to help address risks.

DRA Closes
Submit the Disaster Readiness Assessment in SmartGrants to identify risks and abatement plans for your organization.

Abatement Activities Due
All Abatement Activities must be completed and submitted by 3/31.

Abatement Process Closes
Abatement Activities are reviewed, and final ROC score is determined.
