What is the DRA?

The **Disaster Readiness Assessment (DRA)** is a required **questionnaire** that aims to identify how well your organization is **prepared to recover**.

All DRA questions are broken down into five sub-categories:

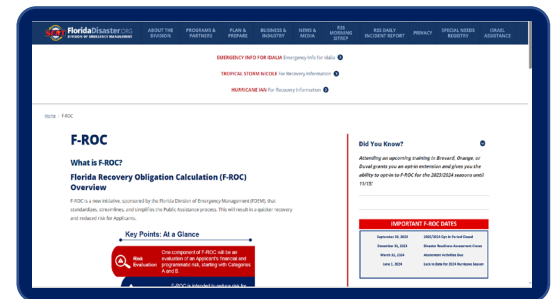
Applicant Experience	Policy and Procedure	Documentation	Procurement	Contract Administration
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Here's how you can benefit from completing the DRA:

- ✓ Completing the DRA enables you to **increase your overall F-ROC score**, and therefore your ability to recover a higher percentage of funding upfront upon obligation.
- ✓ Completing the DRA enables you to **identify risks** in your organization.
- ✓ Completing the DRA offers **abatement plans** to help address risks.

Forms will have cover pages with a purpose and detailed description of each field.



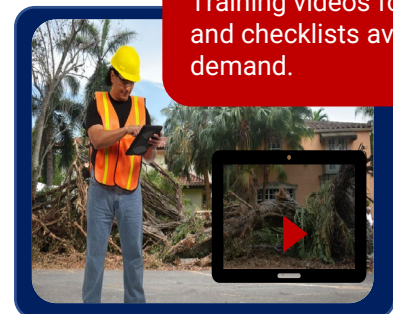

10/31/24

DRA Closes

Submit the Disaster Readiness Assessment in SmartGrants to identify risks and abatement plans for your organization.

3/31/25

Abatement Activities Due

All Abatement Activities must be completed and submitted by 3/31.

6/01/25

Abatement Process Closes

Abatement Activities are reviewed, and final F-ROC score is determined.

6/1/25 - Lock In Date for 2025 Hurricane Season
